5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

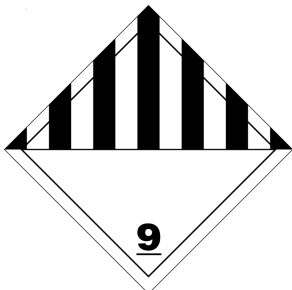
